Workforce Solutions Greater Dallas announces the opportunity to give public comments for the 2017 – 2020 Dallas County Workforce Development Plan for the countywide workforce systems, which includes investments of approximately \$95,000,000 annually. Workforce Solutions Greater Dallas responds to the talent identification and development needs of employers in Dallas County, assisting over 140,000 workers annually. Federal and State funded programs within the system include WIOA Title I (Adult, Dislocated Worker and Youth formula programs); Adult Education and Literacy Act programs; Wagner-Peyser Act; Rehabilitation Act Title I; and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF). Additional partner programs referenced in the plan include Trade Adjustment Assistance; Unemployment Compensation; YouthBuild (operating in Fort Worth); Local Veterans' Employment Representatives and Disabled Veterans' Outreach; HUD Employment and Training Programs; Senior Community Service Employment; Job Corps; and National Farmworker Jobs Program. Our local system also includes U.S. Department of Agriculture Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program E&T, Childcare Assistance, Childcare Quality, Childcare Protective Services. Activities are operated via the local America's Job Centers and local partnership agreements.
