The questions below were submitted by potential respondents to the RFQ/RFP as instructed. The supplied answers are neither an effort that alters the RFQ/RFP, nor does the Q&A bind the Workforce Solutions Greater Dallas (WFSDallas) to further requirements before or after this process.

- 1) Are the due dates relative to the proposal type? Or can any submission be sent in by any one of the three due dates? **Please see Q&A question #1 dated February 15, 2019.**
- 2) Also, where can I find the attachment forms A-K as I do not see them in the pdf file? Please find the attached link for the attachments: <https://www.wfsdallas.com/doing-business> **The attachment link is located directly below the RFQ/RFP document.**
- 3) I notice that Attachment B (Professional Development and/or Other Innovative Activities Proposal) includes areas to submit 2 proposed trainings. Is it possible to submit 3 Innovative Activities proposals for consideration? If so, can they be submitted on the same document? **Yes, you can submit more than 2 trainings within the same proposal.**
- 4) I am a Registered Trainer with the TECPDS (#1942) and am interested in applying for your RFQ. In reading the document, I see that we may submit 3 trainings but that 1 must be specific to infant and toddler care. **Within this procurement, we have an emphasis on infant and toddler care; however, you may submit other trainings that meet the requirements of the procurement document.**
- 5) My professional developments are focused on hands-on science experiments and activities for young children, and while there is much discussion about child safety, I am not sure any of my trainings are specific to the "care" of infants and toddlers. However since I do train the participants on child safety when teaching STEM, would that qualify as "infant and toddler care?" **Within this procurement, we have an emphasis on infant and toddler care; however, you may submit other trainings that meet the requirements of the procurement document.
