The fairs hosted by the three organizations are expected to draw thousands of job seekers, feature more than 400 employers seeking to fill more than 18,000 vacancies and are part of “Hiring Red, White & You!” a statewide initiative sponsored by the Texas Workforce Commission.

“Hiring Red, White & You!” will connect job seekers including veterans, transitioning military members and their spouses with employers across the North Central Texas region who are actively seeking skilled workers, and will include a variety of industries, including healthcare, technology, logistics, manufacturing, and more.

These job fairs are open to the public, but priority access will be given to veterans, transitioning military members, and their spouses. This year's effort is particularly important, because Texas is home to 1.5 million veterans and 15 major military installations, including the Army Futures Command. With more than 22,000 uniformed service members exiting the military and remaining or returning to Texas each year, the transition from military service to civilian employment presents unique challenges.
