What does the WIOA program provide?

WIOA is a no-cost employment program designed to provide job seekers with the skills training and support they need to find a high-demand job. Specifically, WIOA can provide:

- Funding for occupational training services, including tuition, textbooks, tools, supplies, clothing/work uniforms, and certification payments/exams
- Employment search assistance
- Job readiness assistance
- Child care assistance while in training
- Career exploration and assessments
- Individualized career management

How do I know if I'm eligible?

The WIOA program is available to low-income adult, youth, and dislocated Texas workers living in Dallas County.

Basic eligibility* for the program includes:

- Must be a United States citizen or eligible* to work in the United States
- If male and born after January 1, 1960, must be registered with the Selective Service

Verify registration: sss.gov/verify/

To register: sss.gov/register/

- Must have proof of a social security number

Eligible* Individuals Must Also Either:

1. Have earned an annual salary **less than:**
