#### **MINUTES**

Chair, Harry Jones called the Board of Directors' meeting to order at 8:06 a.m. and welcomed everyone.

#### **Conflict of Interest**

#### **Chairman's Comments**

Chair, Harry Jones briefly reiterated his remarks from the previous board meeting, discussing the importance of compliance, securing funding, and building upon relationships, internally and externally.

#### **Approval of Consent Agenda**

Approval of September 17, 2025, Board Minutes

It was recommended that the Board review and approve September 17, 2025, minutes.

#### Policy – Adopting State Rule

No Local Flexibility (NLF) – Texas Workforce Commission issued policy as indicated on page 14 of the board packet.

It was recommended that the board give authorization to approve the TWC policies as described.

#### **External Grants and Partnerships**

Jobs for the Future, TWC Self-Sufficiency Grant, TWC Skills Development Grant, TWC – Pre-Apprenticeship, and TWC – Self-Sufficiency, as noted on page 14 of the board packet.

It was recommended that the Board give authorization to approve external grants as presented above, in addition to approval of all above recommendations under the consent agenda.

Bill O'Dwyer made the motion to accept the above recommendations. The motion passed with Dan Micciche seconding.

#### **Achievement Alliance Committee**

Chair, Rebecca Acuña briefed the board on recent events, future apprenticeship training programs for hospitality, and social media growth.

#### **Child Care Advisory Council**

Chair, Karen Hughes briefed the board on programs and trainings provided through the partners that are included in the contract for quality funds for childcare. Staff is working on the Child Care Quality Plan that will be sent to TWC by October 30<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Contracts and Agreements**

Executive Vice President, Demetria Robinson, briefed the board on five (5) total action items, as presented on page 17 of the board packet.

#### <u>Adult Education & Literacy – Contract Amendment</u>

It was recommended that the board authorization to amend the AEL Consortium partner contracts with Dallas College, Irving ISD, and Wilkinson Center.

#### Registered Apprenticeship Program - Contract

It was recommended that the board authorize to contract with Correlation One at cost not to exceed \$426,870 to deliver the training program services effective October 15, 2025.

#### Workforce System Operations – Contract Amendment

It was recommended that the board authorize to amend C2 Global Professional Services' existing contract.

#### Interim President to Amend Contracts with Additional Funding

It was recommended that the board authorize for the Interim President to execute necessary contracts and/or amendments to incorporate additional funding received prior to the next scheduled board meeting, with full board ratification at the next scheduled board meeting.

Ken Malcolmson made the motion to accept the above recommendations. The motion passed with Michelle Thomas seconding.

Executive Vice President, Demetria Robinson, continued to brief the board on the final action item, as presented on page 18 of the board packet.

#### FY2026 Child Care Local Match Partnership agreement – Update

It was recommended that the board authorize to accept the contribution for the Local Match agreement as specified on page 18 of the board packet as part of the CCG FY2026 contract to provide direct care for eligible children.

Ken Malcolmson made the motion to accept the above recommendations. The motion passed with Carolyn Dent seconding and one abstention from Rebecca Acuña.

#### **Procurement**

Senior Vice President, Connie Rash, briefed the board on procurement as shown on page 19 of the board packet for Annual Audit and Tax Services, and Office Furnishings.

It was recommended that the board authorize to purchase office furnishings with Business Interiors and a ratified amount will be presented at the next board meeting.

Ken Malcolmson made the motion to accept the above recommendation. The motion passed with Bill O'Dwyer seconding and two abstentions from Rolinda Duran and Crystal Sanders.

Senior Vice President, Connie Rash, continued with the final procurement as shown on page 19 of the board packet for Healthcare Insurance for a Small Group.

It was recommended that the board authorize to approve a new broker agreement with MarshMcLennan Agency to renew our health insurance at the best rate we can receive.

Ken Malcolmson made the motion to approve the above recommendation. The motion passed with Karen Hughes seconding and two abstentions from Rolinda Duran and Crystal Sanders.
