Walmart Wins Award at Texas Workforce Conference

Award honors Large Employer of the Year



DALLAS – Walmart, nominated by Workforce Solutions Greater Dallas, was chosen as Texas' Large Employer of the Year at the Texas Workforce Commission's (TWC) 27th Annual Conference held Dec. 4 - Dec. 6, 2024, in Grapevine. TX. Local Workforce Development Boards nominate employers who make a positive impact on workers, the community, and the state through their partnerships with Texas Workforce Solutions.

Walmart Perishable Distribution Center 8348 located in Lancaster, TX partnered with Workforce Solutions Greater Dallas (WFSDallas), Dallas College, the Southern Dallas County Inland Port Transportation Management Association, and the Texas Veterans Commission to hire 15 experienced maintenance technicians and entry-level workers to fill various positions. They attracted over 100 applicants through job postings, presentations, hiring events, and veteran outreach, and ultimately reviewed 40 top candidates. Beyond the initial hiring, Walmart's continued partnership with WFSDallas includes ongoing initiatives that attract hundreds of candidates for positions paying \$21.65 to \$37.50 per hour.
